Cottages

Active Retirement

Cottage residents enjoy all the benefits of the Franke Tobey Jones campus while living in a more private, residential setting. Our beautifully designed Cottages are 2-bedroom, 2-bath homes with a

well-appointed layout—and maintenance-free, inside and out. Each is comprised of a 1,344 sq. ft. living area, plus an oversized 374 sq. ft. attached garage. High ceilings, gas fireplaces, walk-in closets, hardwood floors and luxurious carpeting, full kitchens with oak cabinetry and breakfast nook and pantry, washer and dryer, skylights and three bay windows, covered patio/deck, high-tech wiring for cable and computers, emergency/security system, plenty of storage and more are included.



Our Place

24-Hour Alzheimer's and Dementia Care

Our Place is a specially designed home-like residence for seniors with early stage Alzheimer's or other dementia. These residents have the best view on campus with a lovely and secure balcony overlooking Commencement Bay. Under the direction of a Licensed Nurse, Certified Nursing Aides and Activity Coordinators, the *Our Place* day is structured to maximize the quality of life for residents. Assistance with the activities of daily living is provided to ensure needs are met 24 hours a day. Meals are served in a family-style, private dining room. Meaningful activities are designed to enhance residents' strengths while bringing pleasure to their days. Programs encourage socialization, reminiscing, movement, use of cognitive function, wellness, spiritual traditions and the maintenance of established hobbies and tasks. Community members may attend *Our Place* on an hourly day care basis if space is available. The goals of *Our Place* are twofold: to provide a sense of security and belonging through reassuring staff in a place that looks and feels like home; and to add quality of life through a daily routine that incorporates creating, reflecting and conversing. As shared by one of the residents, "It's like home. We're one big, happy family."



Health Care Center

24-Hour Nursing Care



This family-like center boasts a unique and friendly atmosphere and provides our residents and their families with a multitude of amenities and the peace of mind of the most qualified clinical staff around. Both private and semi-private rooms, each with 1 bathroom, are available in our “private pay” Washington State Licensed skilled nursing area. Our Registered Nurses, Licensed Practical Nurses, Certified Nurses Aides, Restorative Aides, Social Worker and Activity Coordinators round out the active and engaging, yet peaceful and practical environment of quality care. Electric beds, housekeeping and laundry services are supplied. The Salon and Spa staff pick up and drop off residents for their favorite hairstyle or manicure/pedicure. Three delicious meals a day are served in a private dining room with attentive servers and staff. A servery in the dining room allows residents to see and smell the tantalizing meals, which increases appetites and encourages healthy eating habits. Hospice, physical therapy, occupational therapy and speech therapy are available.



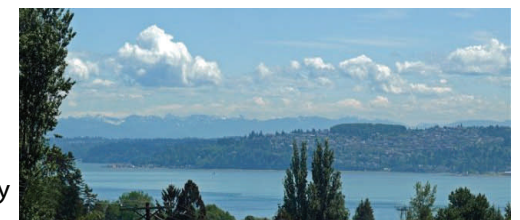
Garden Apartments
