Senior University at Franke Tobey Jones provides a wealth of programs for lifelong learning for older adults, both those residing on campus and in the surrounding community. The concept of a concentrated educational and cultural program designed for seniors is unique in Pierce County.

Senior University offers people 55 or better many opportunities to build skills, explore new subjects and enjoy the learning process with others. Lecturers and instructors are experts in their fields hailing from local colleges and universities, businesses, nonprofits, cultural organizations along with others who have retired with rich career experiences. Most classes are offered free of charge as a public service to the Tacoma-Pierce County community. A sampling of our classes are below.

Senior University is also a national partner with Elderhostel's Road Scholar program bringing several programs a year to our friendly campus featuring regional experts on broad ranging topics such as Norman Rockwell, the United Nations and American music.

Seniors On Broadway, an annual collaboration with the Broadway Center for the Performing Arts, in which students learn music, movement, spoken word and other performance modes to present a showcase performance at the end of the term.

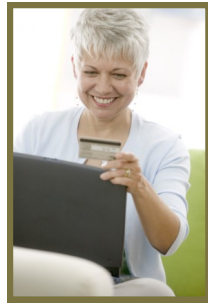
University of Puget Sound

Series, a variety of faculty and topics gleaned from the college community include everything from British literature to astronomy to aging to history.

Music with Dr. Paul, a monthly talk throughout the academic year from Dr. Paul Schultz, artistic director of the Northwest Repertory Singers, whose subjects range from classical music to musical comedy.

Tacoma Historical Society's

Landmark Series, a monthly talk from local historians on local history ranging from ethnic communities to buildings to events.
