The Honeycrooners

A fabulous kick off to our Summer Concerts on the Lawn—The Honeycrooners direct from British Columbia, is a tribute to the glory days of Las Vegas, capturing the groovy sound and cool vibe of the Crooners that made the Strip the place to be and to be seen. Started in 1971 by Bert Barr, Uptown Lowdown Jazz has performed continuously appearing at over 25 festivals and concerts annually throughout the United States and abroad. Major festivals include The Sacramento Jazz Jubilee, Sun Valley Swing & Dixie, The Great Connecticut Jazz Festival, San Diego Jazz Festival, Pismo Beach Jazz and America's Festival in Lacey, WA. The six piece band has a worldwide reputation having performed in Japan, Holland, Belgium, Germany and 15 international cruises.
