It's a new year and we have big plans! There is much work ahead of us as we prepare to break ground for a new health center and memory support building. Yet even as we dedicate time to campus changes, we continue to put philanthropic dollars to work to meet our mission of serving local seniors. Our mission is always at the heart of what we do. Generous gifts made a difference in 2016: six team members received Employee Scholarships to pursue further education; over \$400,000 in charitable subsidy supported residents in financial need, we taught 360 Senior University classes, we held 1,917 Wellness classes, we funded over a dozen special projects on campus, and the Point Defiance~ Ruston Senior Center received operating and special projects funding. Philanthropy matters! Your gifts help us touch many lives as we served over 3,000 local seniors in 2016. Thank you and here's to 2017!

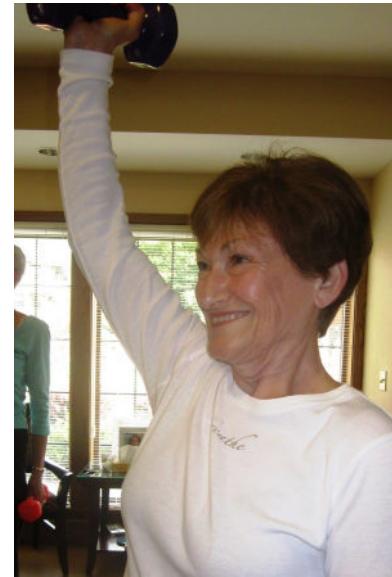
