You can feel the growing excitement of residents, family members and staff, despite the seeming chaos that goes along with a building project. Beyond the excitement of beginning our journey to reposition the Franke Tobey Jones campus, in 2017 we:

- Had a perfect Department of Health and Human Services survey in our Assisted Living areas.
- Began an aggressive plan to redecorate the entire Lillian Pratt building.
- Continued Mrs. Jones' spirit of serving the greater Tacoma community through;
 - ♦ The management of the Point Defiance ~ Ruston Senior Center, serving approximately 2,100 individuals.
 - ♦ Helping over 500 senior community members stay physically active by offering over 1,600 classes in our Wellness Center.

2018 Happenings

What a wonderful year! The Senior Center remains extremely important to the community it serves. One of the programs we have is a small food bank program. People are able to pick up bread, meat, dairy products and even produce. This program alone has 2,486 participants. For many, this is the only way they are able to supplement their monthly food allowance. There are numerous other important programs that the Senior Center offers the community. There were 850 educational classes, program participants ranged from 268 in foot care, 466 in the trips program to 867 individuals who had their taxes prepared. The wellness program had 7,374 participants and there were 6,128 meals served. And, our wonderful volunteers put in over 10,800 hours last year. Much thanks to them!

Mission Impact

Philanthropic investments made by generous financial supporters help Franke Tobey Jones fully uphold our mission to enrich and extend the quality of life for seniors in our community. We are so grateful to all of our donors for making a difference in the lives of local seniors, both on campus and off campus.

Generous volunteers help us carry out our work each day through their precious gifts of time. In 2017, 145 volunteers served nearly 15,000 hours at Franke Tobey Jones and our Point Defiance~Ruston Senior Center.

Philanthropic support of our on-campus charitable programs and capital project totaled \$557,024 and an additional \$88,565 was contributed to off-set our community outreach programs. These investments made the following possible in 2017:

Charitable Subsidy:

We confidentially distributed over \$400,000 in subsidy to FTJ residents in financial need. Subsidy allows our residents to remain in their home at Franke Tobey Jones, among friends and familiar caregivers, during an usually challenging time of health crisis. Franke Tobey Jones never wants to deny care to a resident because he or she is unable to pay. Therefore, continuing to build the Charitable Subsidy Endowment is a focus of our organization and, ultimately, a benefit to seniors in our local community, who we have been serving since 1924.

Wellness Program

Wellness members participated in 1,835 classes to stay fit and healthy. Studies indicate that older adults who are active and socially engaged maintain their independence, improve physical and mental functioning, stay healthier and live happier more complete lives. Therefore, Franke Tobey Jones offers a multi-faceted Wellness Program that improves quality of life – free to residents and at low-cost to any community senior 55+.

We offered 321 programs for about 400 participants engaging in lifelong learning in 2017. Senior University is an educational and cultural program designed for seniors, who build skills, explore new subjects and enjoy the learning process with others. Lecturers and instructors are experts in their fields hailing from local colleges and universities, businesses, nonprofits and cultural organizations.
