Accommodations

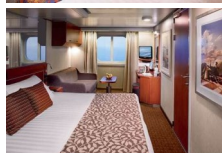
There are several types of staterooms available, ranging from inside cabins to a suite. Only so many in each category are available to us. It is highly advisable to reserve your space prior to May 1 (see Early Bird Special). All prices are per person, based on double occupancy and do not include taxes (\$250 per person).

INSIDE



Approximately 141-284 sq. ft., inside staterooms have two lower beds that convert to one queen-size bed. Inside staterooms start at \$949 and go up to \$989.

OCEANVIEW



Approximately 169-267 sq. ft., ocean view staterooms have two lower beds that convert to one queen-size bed. Ocean view staterooms start at \$1159 and go up to \$1219.

VERANDAH



Approximately 213-379 sq. ft. including verandah, this stateroom has floor-to-ceiling windows overlooking a private verandah. It includes a sitting area and two lower beds that convert to one queen-size bed. Verandah staterooms start at \$1649 and go up to \$1679.

SIGNATURE SUITE



Approximately 273-456 sq. ft. these large, comfortable suites feature a spacious sitting area, floor-to-ceiling windows overlooking a private verandah, two lower beds convertible to one queen-size bed. The suite is \$2399.

Identification

Alaska cruise vacations that begin and end in the United States do not currently require passports for Alaska cruises; however, U.S. Citizens who do not have a valid passport must provide a government issued birth certificate combined with a government issued photo I.D. A passport card, enhanced driver's license or certificate of naturalization along with a government-issued phot ID are also acceptable.

Online check-in is required prior to departure at www.hollandamerica.com. Print out the Express Documents and boarding pass, bringing them with you when you leave home.
