What the Latest Research Tells Us



The Mather Institute, in partnership with Northwestern University, completed a five-year landmark study on how life in a Life Plan Community (CCRC) impacts older adults. It followed 8,000 residents across 122 communities from 2018 to 2022, comparing them with older adults living independently.

Eve-Opening, Encouraging Results

Residents of Life Plan Communities consistently reported higher wellness levels than their peers:

- Physical: Staying active and healthy
- Emotional: Feeling positive and supported
- Intellectual: Engaging in learning and creativity
- Social: Building meaningful connections
- Vocational: Finding purpose through volunteerism or personal projects

Gains Over Time

Even as everyone ages, residents showed distinct strengths:

- Social contact increased (it declined elsewhere).
- Intellectual engagement rose, with more residents involved with educational events and pursuing hobbies.
- Emotional wellness declined slightly but at slower rates than in the general population.

Resilience Through COVID-19

Because the study spanned the pandemic, it offered a rare look at resilience. Despite isolation and uncertainty, residents reported low stress and high resilience—thanks to:

- Close family relationships
- Smaller community settings
- Coping strategies like meditation and creative outlets

What It Means for the Future

The Age Well Study shows that community living fosters healthier, happier aging. Social opportunities, intellectual stimulation and belonging aren't just "nice to have"—they're proven to enhance well-being. For those planning their future, the findings highlight the value of a community designed for connection and engagement.
